Section 1: Conducting Detailed Functional Analyses (3 units)

This workshop will focus on teaching clinical staff to implement experimental analyses with the students they serve. The training includes information on the importance of conducting experimental analyses, identifying when an experimental analysis is needed, conducting the analysis, and analyzing the results. In addition to a detailed explanation of the Escape, Attention, Tangible, Play, and Demand conditions, attendees will also learn about running modification of the basic five conditions including analysis of precursors, demand variations, and attention variations. Attendees will participate as the therapist and data collector during different conditions of the analysis, will practice analyzing the results of a functional analysis, and will practice developing variations of conditions when the basic five do not lead to easily interpreted results. Upon completion of the workshop, attendees will be able to:

- Determine the need for an experimental analysis
- Design experimental sessions for a student
- Collect data using an experimental analysis data sheet
- Graphically display data collected from an experimental analysis
- Analyze data collected during an experimental analysis to determine function of a behavior

Section 2: Ethics and Professionalism: Behavior Analysis in Practice (3 units)

The purpose of this workshop is to provide the participants with critical thinking skills and communication skills related to ethical practices as a behavior analyst in clinical settings. In particular, we will provide training in the following areas:

- **The Behavior Analyst Certification Board's (BCBA) Task List and Guidelines of Ethical Conduct:** Participants will review the specific BCBA code of ethics. They will divide into groups and discuss scenarios related to challenges with which behavior analysts are often faced in a clinical setting. Participants in this workshop will discuss with each other ways of addressing these challenges.
- **Strategies for Professional Interactions:** Participants will learn about the book How to Win Friends and Influence People by Dale Carnegie from a behavior analytic perspective. Participants will role play situations in which behavior analysts are often faced. They will practice communicating in a professional way based on the techniques discussed throughout the workshop.
