A parol (pronounced [pa'rol], US: /pɑ:'roʊl/ (also written as paról or parul) is a Filipino ornamental lantern displayed during the Christmas season. Parols are traditionally constructed using bamboo and Japanese paper, and are illuminated with candles, oil lamps, or carbide lamps.
