EXTENDED SCHOOL YEAR- THE TOP 10 REASONS FOR ATTENDING ESY!

- 10. It's fun! Our school will hold weekly activities that will take place on site as well as in our local community. Activities will include hands on activities, interleague sports days, and more.
- 9. Research shows that reading scores improve with summer reading, and that the achievement gap in reading scores between those who do and do not participate in summer reading can grow by 6 months or more.
- 8. **Its' fun!** Students will receive special rewards and be able to participate in student store events to reward their daily attendance.
- 7. Students make progress on their IEP goals, both academically and socially.
- 6. Students improve their health through daily physical activity and routine when they attend our summer session.
- 5. **It's fun!** Reading, Writing, Research, and Art Activities center around high interest thematic units.
- 4. Social skills are improved through the cooperation and respectful interaction that are a part of the projects and shared activities student participate in during this time.
- 3. Students on diploma track can have additional time to obtain credits for credit recovery.
- 2. Students will continue to make progress toward their goals of transitioning to a less restrictive environment. Progress will be reported to parents/care providers and districts at the end of the summer.
