Dear Parents/Guardians and District Providers

I want to start out with saying how proud I am of all our students for doing an amazing job virtually and on campus with their academics. The past 8 months I know none of us want to repeat. It has been extremely challenging conducting school remotely for all, but extremely challenging for families. Adults at home supporting our students are the "Rock Stars" making sure your child joins virtual class, being attentive and participates. We have about 90% of our students that have returned to campus 2 to 4 days a week. Starting next week **November 9th** we are offering 5 days a week back on campus for those families that feel comfortable with their child being on campus 5 days. 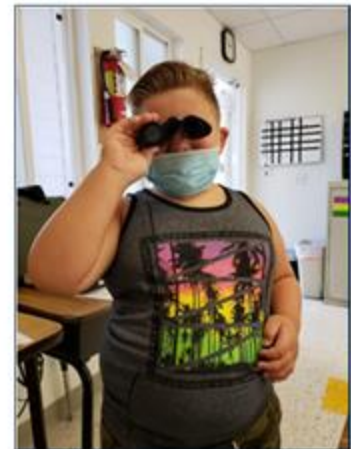
