Santa Clause brought individual gifts for every boy and girl at Spectrum-Antioch.

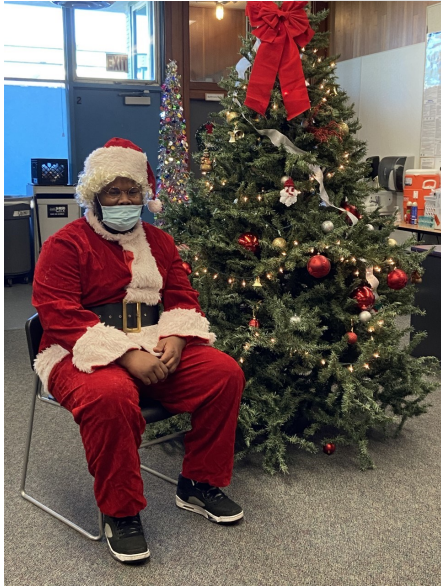
